There are many great organizations in Massachusetts dedicated to helping those who are homeless and others in need. Provision Ministry supports the missions of over 20 such organizations by providing important items they require.

This year, through generous donations, Provision Ministry has provided brand new winter coats and clothing, new socks and hats, hygiene products like soap and toothpaste, useful home goods, and new backpacks and school supplies valued at \$1.4 million to partners in Massachusetts serving the homeless and underserved children and families.

Provision is strategically targeting the following cities in Massachusetts: Worcester, Lowell, Boston, Springfield, Framingham, and newly added, New Bedford and Fall River.
